Atlanta - Things to Do

Georgia Aquarium

As one of Atlanta's newest attractions, the Georgia Aquarium has a simple claim to fame: It is the largest aquarium in the world.

What to Do

Go underwater! Experience a view usually reserved for divers in a signature tunnel in the Ocean Voyager exhibit.

What to See

More than 60 exhibits showcase an immense variety of marine life, including playful belugas, massive whale sharks, frolicking otters, and ethereal jellyfish.



World of Coca-Cola

Few could have dreamed that Dr. John S. Pemberton's "headache remedy" of the late 1800s would become the world's most recognized beverage.

What to Do

Visit the Taste It! gallery, which offers free sampling of the 63 beverages marketed by Coca-Cola in nations around the world.

What to See

Revel in the history of Coca-Cola and view the galleries devoted to advertising campaigns, the bottling process, and Coke in pop culture.



Fernbank Museum of Natural History

Surrounded by a 65-acre (26.3 hectares) forest, the Fernbank Museum of Natural History offers an observatory, a planetarium, an IMAX movie theater, and oodles of fascinating exhibits.

What to Do

Participate in Nature's hands-on activities that helps visitors become aware of how their senses interpret the world around them.

What to See

Discover virtual waterfalls and the insides of a mighty red oak tree at NatureQuest, which lets kids explore the nooks and crannies of a multi-level clubhouse.



[Zoo Atlanta](#)

Occupying nearly 40 acres (16 hectares) in Grant Park, Zoo Atlanta's lush natural habitats showcase more than 1,000 animals representing some 200 species from around the world.

What to Do

Spend a day exploring the nearly 40 acres (16 hectares) in Grant Park. If you have kids, visiting Zoo Atlanta is one of the best family things to do in Atlanta.

What to See

The zoo is best known for its gorillas – more reside here than anywhere else in the United States – and for being one of four U.S. zoos that house giant pandas.



[College Football Hall of Fame](#)

Do you have college football fans in your family? Then you won't want to miss Atlanta's most interactive attraction, the College Football Hall of Fame and Chick-fil-a Fan Experience.

What to Do

Kick a field goal or play quarterback on the 45-yard replica football field.

What to See

Watch the ultra-high-definition 4K feature film *The Game of Your Life*, a behind-the-scenes look into game day on a college team.



[Martin Luther King Jr. National History Site](#)

Visitors can pay tribute and learn about Martin Luther King Jr. at this National Historic Site.

What to Do

Hear recordings of his sermons and speeches that play inside the church, bringing his message – in his own voice – to new generations of listeners.

What to See

His childhood home; his crypt, with eternal flame; Ebenezer Baptist Church, where he served as pastor; and a visitor center that showcases his important civil rights work.



[Piedmont Park](#)

Since 1904, Piedmont Park has encouraged visitors to engage with nature.

What to Do

Explore the sports fields, skating and biking paths – separated from well-marked jogging and walking paths – and a dog park where four-legged friends romp leash-free invite both casual and organized play.

What to See

The Noguchi Playscape, an intersection of shape, color and texture designed for active and enthusiastic interaction.
